韩国济州岛特色

第一天 吉隆坡 / 济州岛 (机上用餐/晚) 第三天 济州岛 (早午晚)

集合于吉隆坡国际机场，办理登机手续，乘搭国际航班飞往美丽的韩国济州岛。抵达济州岛机场后，将开始我们的旅程。首先将前往济州岛 - **树木园主题乐园冰雕博物馆**。第一个四季常设的室内冰雕展示馆，一年四季365天，不论季节、气温，全年保持零下5°C。**冰雕博物馆**展示了代表济州的泰迪熊冰雕、热带鱼、及象征今年龙年的冰雕。除此之外还有北极村的冰屋、冰滑梯等，各式的冰雕展示。接着，将前往游览**龙头岩**，此岩是火山爆发时喷出的熔岩在海中凝结在海上而成，模样有如龙头。然后前往被称为“鬼路”的**神奇之路**。

酒店：济州岛贝尼克酒店（当地4星酒店或同级）

早餐后，前往济州**民俗村博物馆**，里面保存完整的巫师村、济州衙门、集市、无形文化遗产之家、农具陈列馆等117座建筑，生动地再现了19世纪90年代济州的模样。这里还是《大长今》在济州最主要的拍摄基地。毕后，将前往**新昌风车海岸**。海面上矗立一整排巨大的风力发电风车，与白色灯塔和跨海人行路桥，看起来像是画报、杂志才会出现的风景。随后，前往浏览**独立岩**及**偶来小路**，它位于三梅峰公园前海，是在约150万年前的火山爆发时期，由大量的火山熔岩在难以形容的伟大自然力作用下，造就出的胜景。独立岩高约20多米，亦被称为将军岩或孤石浦。毕后，前往**药泉寺**，以朝鲜初期典型佛教建筑样式所建，地上高达30m(相当于一般建筑10层楼左右)。接着，游览在济州道西归浦市的**柱状节理带**，可见石柱在海岸边层层堆积。这是济州岛的自然保护对象。柱状节理带是汉拏山喷出的熔岩流入中文地区前海时冷却而成，由大大小小的四方或六角型的石柱(30公尺)组成。这里还以惊涛拍打近20公尺高的悬崖以及海边垂钓而有名。

第二天 济州岛 (早午晚) 第四天 济州岛 (早午)

早餐后，前往游览**城山日出峰**，海拔182米，系10万年前海底火山爆发而形成，城山日出峰顶观日出可谓叹为观止。这里于2000年7月19日被指定为地方天然纪念物，2007年被联合国教科文组织指定为世界自然遗产。。毕后，参观**涉地可支**，位于济州岛东部海岸的一端。“涉地”是这一地区古时的名称，“可支”则是济州方言，意为向外突出的地形。涉地可支所在的海岸悬崖上是一片宽阔的草地，没有一棵树木，海岸上耸立着一块名为仙石的岩石。然后，将前往参观**城邑民俗村**，可以看到宅屋的屋顶是以茅草覆盖，院墙是以石头砌成，还有民宅的门户是以木架取代。毕后，前往**天地渊瀑布**，相传天地渊瀑布得名乃因天与地希望能相连，固以此大水瀑做为连结点，串起天上地下的关联，最令人惊奇的尚有当水瀑落地后所形成深约20公尺的水潭，使参天的绝壁高崖与入地的水潭仿佛连接天上地下的距离。它由树木茂盛的悬崖绝壁轰然直泄而下，相传湖底栖息着一尾鳗。接着，前往游览**泰迪熊博物馆**，在内展示着各国不同造型的玩偶熊。随后，参观**奥雪绿茶博物馆**，是一座综合型韩国茶文化展览馆，向游客讲述著韩国茶文化的变迁史、茶叶的制作过程、茶叶的用途、茶的种类等相关知识。

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早餐后，前往浏览**涯月海岸道路**。涯月海岸道路是沿着济州岛西北部的海岸修建的公路，拥有着诱人的海边景色，被称为济州海岸公路中风景最美的地段。公路紧贴着形态弯曲的黑礁石海岸，沿途可观赏到礁石绝壁、白色的浪花与清澈碧蓝的大海，还有很多处视野开阔的展望台和充满浪漫气氛的咖啡屋。过后，前往**龙渊**，是汉川江下流河水和海水交汇的地方，过去曾有龙王世子在此出现过的传说。龙渊湖两边有8块岩壁像屏风一样围绕着，而著名龙渊夜泛就是瀛洲12景之一。过去文人墨客，夜间常乘船来到奇岩绝壁前，欣赏倒映在水面的岩壁美景，久而久之，就有了龙渊夜泛的叫法。毕后，前往济州岛内历史最悠久的建筑物之一**观德亭**，是世宗30年(1448)牧使辛淑晴为了训练士兵而创建的。观德亭取义为“射箭的人平时修身养性，训练德行”，观德亭的梁柱上刻画着十长生图，赤壁大捷图，大狩猎图等格调较高的壁画，观德亭的匾额是安平大君流传下来的亲笔题字。接着，参观**人蔘专卖店**、**护肝宝专卖店**、**化妆品总汇**和**免税店**。随后，前往浏览**涯洞街**，是济州岛旅游购物的好去处，全长450米，可以买到各种小吃，当地特产如汉拿峰橘子等。

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第五天 济州岛/吉隆坡 (早/机上用餐)

早餐后，将前往**土特产店**自由购物，作最后冲刺，购买韩国当地特产。毕后，前往国际机场乘搭班机，带着美好回忆飞返吉隆坡。

KOREA JEJU ISLAND SPECIAL

DAY 1 KUALA LUMPUR / JEJU ISLAND (MOB/D)

Assemble at Kuala Lumpur International Airport for your departure flight to Jeju Island. Upon arrival, we will start our journey at Jeju. First will visit to **Jeju Arboretum Theme Park** is a place for anyone who wishes to be in harmony with the beautiful nature in Jeju. **The Ice museum**, which was first made in Jeju, displays sophisticated artistic iced sculptures. Also there is a place where visitors can personally touch and appreciate the frozen works of art. You can see how formative ice can be. After this, will visit to **Yongduam Rock**, this rock is volcanic rock that is emitted when a volcanic eruption of lava in the sea. Then visit to **Mysterious Road** experience in violation to the attractiveness of the mysterious of nature.

DAY 2 JEJU ISLAND (BLD)

After breakfast, proceed to **Seongsan Ilchulbong Sunrise Peak**, which is 180m above sea level, erupted underwater in the ocean about 5,000 years ago, which makes it a very rare case among the many craters in Jeju Island. Then will visit to **Seopjikoji** is located at the end of the eastern shore of Jeju Island and boasts a fantastic scenery especially in April when yellow canola flowers are in full bloom. "Seopji" is the old name for the area, and "Koji" is Jeju dialect meaning a sudden bump on land. After this, visit to **Seongeup Folk Village**, cultural properties in the folk village have been handed down from generation to generation and include treasures such as residential houses, Confucian shrines and schools, ancient government offices, stone statues, large millstones (pulled by horses or ox), fortress ruins, and stone monuments. After that, proceed to **Cheonjiyeon Waterfalls** which meaning of "sky connected with land," appears to fall from the heavens, giving the falls its name. Then, visit to **Teddy Bear Museum**, offers a glimpse into the unique lifestyle of Teddy Bears. Then will visit **O'sulloc Tea Museum**, was the first tea museum opened by Amore Pacific in 2001 with the aim of introducing and spreading Korean teas and the traditional tea culture of Korea. The museum is a cultural space where the West and the East, and modernity and tradition coexist in harmony.

DAY 3 JEJU ISLAND (BLD)

After breakfast, visit to **Jeju Folklore & Natural History Museum**. It contains information on the natural history of geological features and marine organisms and recreates the traditional lifestyle of Jeju islanders. Jeju Folk Village Museum has comprehensively organized Jeju's traditional folklore materials by setting 1890, the end of the Joseon Dynasty, as its base year and has put them on display for all to see. Next, will proceed to visit **Sinchang Windmill Coastal Road**, on the northwest side of Jeju Island and has a distinctive offshore wind farm as a prominent landmark. The white

windmills and emerald waters along the winding shoreline are a refreshing example of the autumn landscape and an environmentally friendly way to generate electricity. This road is also one of the most beautiful places to view the sunset. After that, visit to **Oedolgae** and **Olle Trail**, it is not far from the shores of Sammaebong, Seogwipo. It is an amazing rock 10 meters in circumference and 20 meters in height and is also known as Jangguseok Rock. It was also a filming location for TV drama series, "Daejanguem". It is an amazing rock 10 meters in circumference and 20 meters in height and is also known as Jangguseok Rock. Then, proceed to the architectural style of **Yakcheonsa Temple** is reminiscent of that of Buddhist temples of the early Joseon Dynasty. Measuring an impressive 30m high and spanning a total area of 3,305 meters squared, it is the largest temple in the East. Then will visit **Jusangjeolli Cliff**, was formed when the lava from Hallasan Mountain erupted into the sea of Jungmun. They are rock pillars shaped like cubes or hexagons of various sizes and almost seem as if stone masons had carved them out.

DAY 4 JEJU ISLAND (BLD)

After breakfast, visit to the **Aewol-Hagwi Coastal Road** known as the most famous of all coastal roads. This road will lead you to Gwakchi, Hyeopjae and Geumneung Beaches, which are among the best in Jeju. The country villages alongside the coastal road make for perfect scenery and photo opportunities. Next proceed to **Yongyeon Pond** was formed by fresh water collecting at the end of a mountain valley before meeting the salty sea water. The pond is so deep, the bottom cannot be seen. The wooden Yongyeon Cloud Bridge crossing the pond and the pavilion are in harmony with the valley landscape. Legend has it that the pond was created by the water raining down off of a dragon that ascended to heaven. The name, meaning Dragon Pond, also comes from the belief that the dragon of Yongduam (Dragon Head Rock) just 200m to the West would come to this pond to play. After that, visit to **Gwandeokjeong Pavilion**, one of the oldest standing architectures on Jeju Island, Gwandeokjeong Pavilion was built by Pastor Sin Suk-Cheong in the thirtieth year of King Sejong's reign (1448) as a training ground. Then will visit to **Ginseng center, Korea Herb center Raisin tree, cosmetic shop and duty free shop**. Upon finished, will visit to **Yeondong Shopping Street**, it also known to locals as Jewon Saguri, is an entire neighborhood of retail stores.

Hotel: Benikea Jeju Hotel or similar (Local 4 stars hotel)

DAY 5 JEJU ISLAND / KUALA LUMPUR (B/MOB)

After breakfast, proceed to **Local Product Shop** for final shopping. Then proceed to Jeju International Airport for your departure flight back to Kuala Lumpur.
